**II. Direction of the Country** (20 minutes)

Yesterday I had to sign something and the security guard asked for ID. And that is because of 9/11. We've got to do something. people talk about housing issues. And there is no good going here. We should not be in Iraq and we need to be more aggressive. It's a shame. But will we ever get back to where we were?

In general, I don't like the direction because of the war and how it affects so many things.

Afghanistan was totally justified but to go into Iraq we had to have more support. I wouldn't be surprised if terrorists tried to pay North Korea for some of their secrets. Because it affects every day of our lives. And it is just the existence. I don't have nay kids, but if I had them I would be worried as hell.

It's kind of hard to say. The war I'm kind of undecided on. I am waiting to hear how it plays out. there was definitely bad intelligence, but history will decide. if we pull now it would be a total mess. Overall the economy is doing well. The rich are getting richer. There used to be a

manufacture. It is polarizing you are going to see more people doing really well and others poorly. Kerry said the two Americas.
